AFFORDABLE HOUSING - One of the responsibilities of the district council is to assess current and future housing need in the area and this is taken into consideration when planning applications are made. Loxhore hosted a drop-in event on October 20th when 2 members of NDC and a representative of Devon Communities Together spoke to 9 parishioners about affordable housing either to rent or to buy at discounted prices. Neither of these options exists in Loxhore, although they are available a little further afield, but the consensus at the meeting was that neither of these options would be required. However it was felt that open-market, lower cost housing was needed because house prices in Loxhore are in the main out of the reach of younger people but it seems unlikely that a developer would be interested in building smaller, cheaper homes to sell on the open market even if land was available. The parish council is able to put anyone seeking housing for rent or to buy at discounted cost in touch with Devon Home Choice or Colin Savage, a Rural Housing Enabler.

GREEN WASTE – No decision has been reached by the district council with regard to changes to the collection of household or garden waste although a statement is expected soon. Only one Loxhore household responded to the suggestion in the last issue of LL regarding the setting up of a community composting scheme and so this idea has been dropped by the parish council.

TRESPASS – NDC has reported to the parish council that a local landowner has complained about walkers trespassing on his land. We have been asked to remind everyone to use only marked public footpaths and rights of way across fields etc.
