David Smith continues to take responsibility for highway issues and myself, Julie Moir will continue to manage the parish website.

The committee organising the Loxstock event has experienced organisational difficulties which make it impossible to deliver it as planned for June 10th. So for the time being the idea will be put on hold and a scaled down version will be held instead on the same day, from 5 until 10pm. Weather permitting, this will be held outside on the field and will include a barbecue, some musical entertainment and games.

This year's Summer Show is not too far distant. We hope that your preparations are underway, particularly in the gardening department and that you are considering taking part in other classes also. Amazingly this will be the 10th show and so it would be good to see a bumper crop of entry forms this year and as always there is a special plea to Loxhore children and grandchildren to have a go.

Highway Maintenance Update Report from David Smith "Following the public meeting of Loxhore residents back in February, the Parish Council applied to Devon County Council for a highways maintenance grant, which was successful, and received the sum of £6500 in April. A volunteer workforce sub-committee has been formed, comprising myself and Wendy, Nigel and Janet Wright, Chris Comer, and Jim Barr, to decide on what tools and equipment to purchase, the work to be carried out by the village workforce, and dates etc. The Village Hall Committee has kindly agreed that this equipment can be stored in the existing stone built shed. By the time you read this update, it is hoped most of the equipment needed will have been purchased, and our first 'workforce day' arranged, which will include refreshments! Watch out for further announcements in Chris Harrington's emails."
