Loxhore has two places of worship, both of which need maintenance from time to time. The parish church, St. Michael and All Angels, a Grade II listed building, has a leaking tower above the west window and financial support is needed to be able to fix it. The cost of repointing the brickwork with the correct mortar is estimated at £5000 and members of the parish council at their September meeting agreed to donate £200 towards this cost.

**HOUSING NEEDS SURVEY** Sue Southwell (Rural Housing Enabler, Devon Communities Together, Exeter) attended the last parish council meeting to speak about affordable housing and the possibility of conducting another survey in Loxhore. Parish councillors agreed that this would provide useful information and so every household will be contacted at the start of the next year.
