This is potentially the last Loxhore Lines. When Lauri Golds started writing it possibly twenty (or more) years ago fewer people in the village owned or used a computer and so it was a very valuable 'line' of communication. More recently, when he took over as Loxhore contributor to the Community News section of the North Devon Journal, Chris Harrington started his emailed circular and all those who wish to receive it have given him their email address. This is possibly the preferred way of receiving news now so unless someone feels strongly that the Lines is worth keeping and is prepared to take it on it will cease to be published.

After a long battle with BT, the Halsey Lake public phone was finally repaired and the kiosk cleaned at the end of 2018 – for two years or more it hadn't worked. They have refused to remove it at the moment because when consulted back in 2016, the Parish Council requested that it be retained (in working order!) BT will consult with the Parish Council again some time this year which they are obliged to do before removing infrequently used phones. It will be interesting to see if the phone has been used since being mended, as mobile phone signals seem to have improved and particularly at that location. The Parish Council's view is that it should be removed unless there is a strong argument from parishioners for retaining it.

The Kift Cup skittles competition is next on the agenda. Open to everyone, it is played by pairs drawn from whoever turns up on the evening.
